

Goat Gestation Chart

Breed-specific kidding averages for standard and miniature goats. Add breeding date + days = expected kidding.

Quick reference

Standard breeds: 150 days (~5 months) · Miniature breeds: 145 days · Normal range: ± 5 days

Kidding window = average gestation \pm breed variance. Twins and triplets often arrive 1–3 days early.

How to use this chart

1. Find your breed in the table (standard = 150 days, miniature = 145 days).
2. Use the lookup chart or add gestation days to your breeding or AI date.
3. Plan for the ± 5 -day window, not a single calendar day.
4. For trimester milestones and CDT timing, use the free calculator at useturnrow.com/tools/livestock/goat-gestation/
